

## CONNECTION TO A LOW PRESSURE SEWER MAIN

Upon completion of the construction of the wastewater collection system, owners of existing structures will be given the opportunity to connect to the sewer system. For property owners that will connect to a low pressure sewer main, a grinder pump station will be installed on your property. The County will be responsible for constructing the low pressure line in the street right-of-way, the low pressure service sewer service to the property line and the grinder pump station. The grinder pump station will have a 4" sewer service stubbed out of the tank. The actual service will be below ground and deep enough that a sewer service can be constructed from your house or building to the sewer service line.

### HOMEOWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY

The homeowner will be responsible for constructing a gravity sewer service line that intercepts the flow that normally goes to the septic tank and installing a sewer service line that runs from the line that runs to the septic tank to the end of the sewer service at the grinder pump station constructed by the County. The property owner will also be responsible for contracting with an electrician to connect the electrical control of the grinder pump station to the electrical system of the house. The sewer service line may be installed by a licensed plumber or by the property owner. Under the Town of Calabash ordinance, the septic tank must be properly abandoned after connection to the sewer service.
